Case 1

- When Professor B submitted a manuscript for publication, he removed Dr Y as an author and added a senior colleague instead
 - **How would you respond to Dr Y?**
 - **Could anything have been done to prevent this situation from occurring in the first place?**
 - **Are there any wider issues to consider?**

Case 2

- You notice that in three papers written by a Professor, all published in peer reviewed, high profile journals, images that appear identical.
 - **What should you do?**
 - **And what are the next options?**

Case 3

- large portions of Professor Z's most recent article, which appeared in a major national newspaper, was plagiarised substantially from a number of different sources.
 - **How do you respond to the journalist?**
 - **How do you take the matter forward?**

Case 4

- You have been notified of several irregularities in papers from a senior researcher at QMUL
- The researcher agrees these are suspicious
- Attributes to a collaborator in Poland currently under investigation in Poland for fraud
 - **How do you proceed in these circumstances?**

Case 5

- Your post-doc runs the background section of your paper through Chat GPT
- The result reads very well
 - **What should you do?**
