The Year 1 rate in 2027/28 will not be based on an inflationary uplift from the Year 0 rate in 2026/27.				
New Overseas students who transfer to Queen Mary from another university and enter directly into Year 2 or a later year of a programme are charged the rate for the cohort they are joining rather than the new student rate. This includes students transferring to Queen Mary under an international articulation partnership (such as a 2+3 arrangement).
